The history, accessories and literature related to our Classics is just as interesting as the cars themselves. Presented here is a recent eBay find related to Cadillac's 1941 Fleetwood series, the 60 Special sedan and the 75 sedans and limousines. It is a dealer upholstery sample book and measures about 12 by 5 inches, hardbound.

Inside are swatches of the "Dualtone Bedford Cord" used on the 60 Special in tones of blue, tan and green. (The green almost looks gray). Those interior colors are matched to the appropriate 14 exterior paint combinations. For the 75 Series, color choices are tan and gray, presented in three different fabrics: Vogue Broadcloth (featuring a tonal pyramid pattern), Bedford Cord and plain broadcloth.

It seems logical that Cadillac would have also produced a similar swatch book for the 61, 62, 63 and 67 Series that year. Has anyone seen one?
